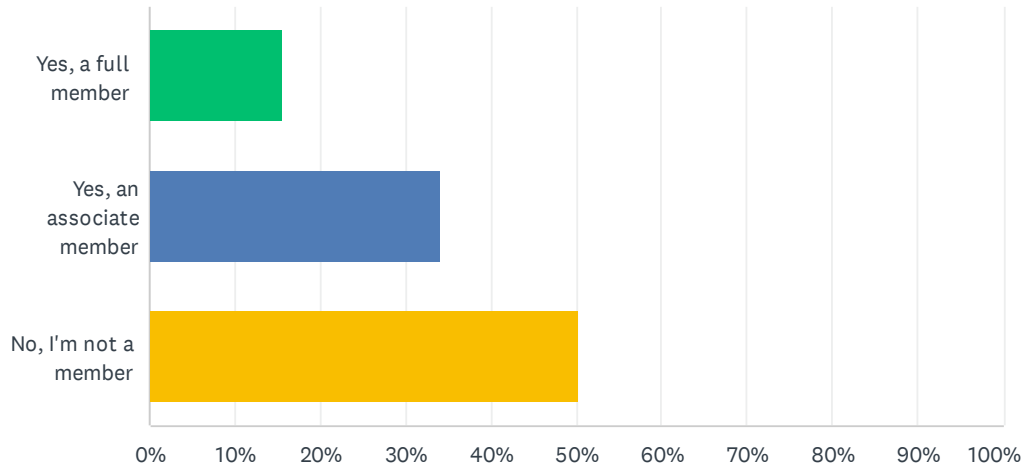


Q1 Are you a member of the SWFC Trust?

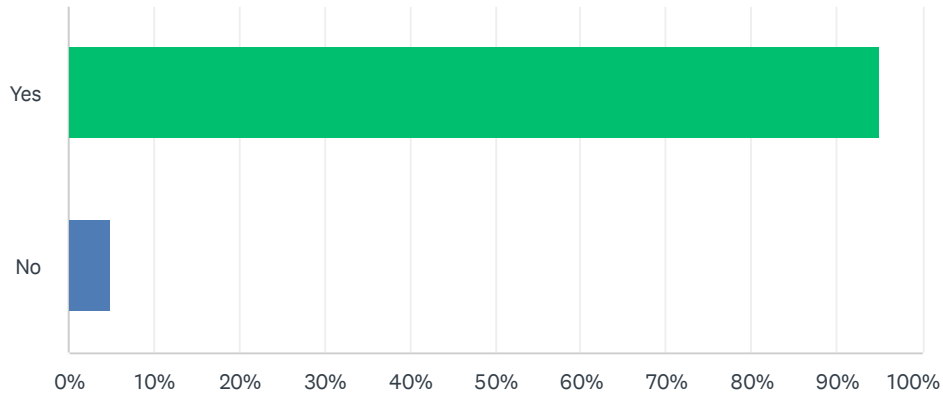

Q2 Do you feel that the phrase 'Enough is Enough' represents how you feel about the performance of the ownership of the club?

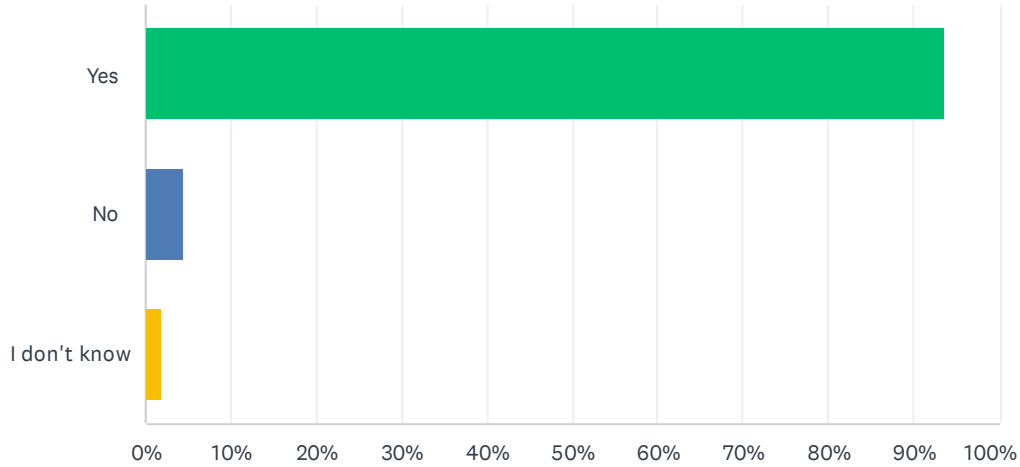

Q3 Do you think the SWFC Trust should request the club publicly share their strategic plan for the future?

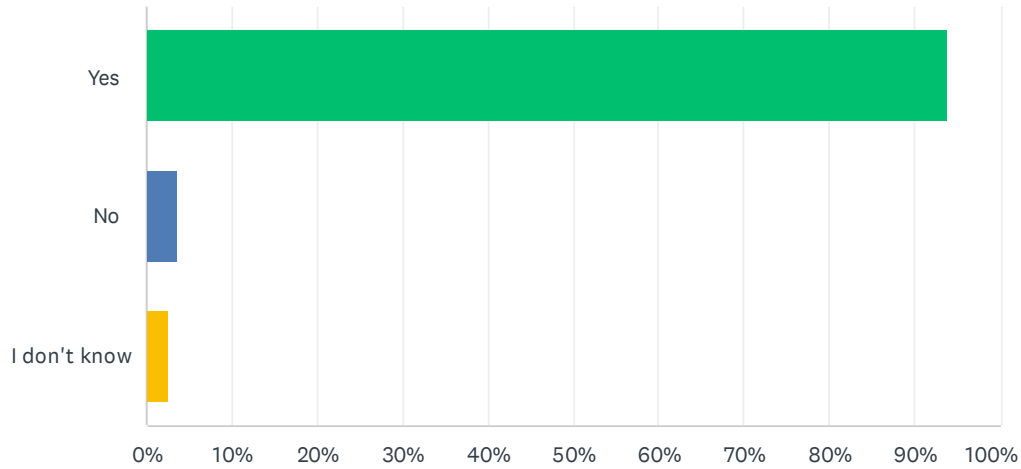

Q4 If no strategic plan is shared by the club, should the Trust demand that the club be sold at fair market value?

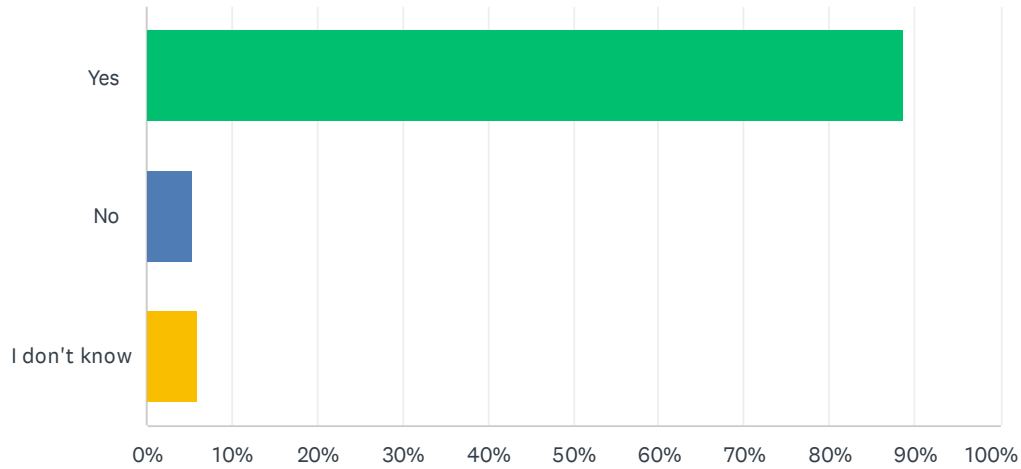

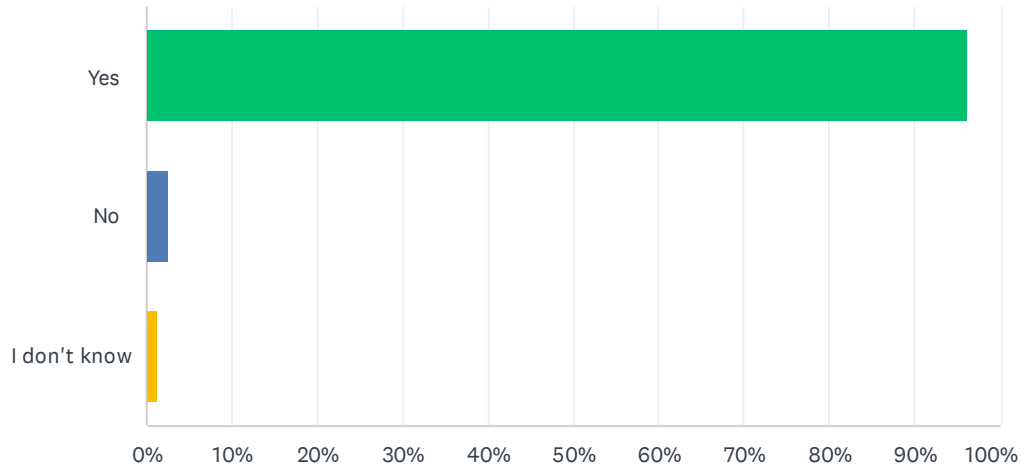
